this autobiography is reflective of the many dimensional attitudes of the author dato jeyaraj c
rajarao as he recounts his life story it is evident that he has lived a life with passion integrity
wit and mischief a life of black and white with very little grey in it the narrative begins with
a simple story of love that spans decades it then takes the reader through a young boy s
experience of the japanese occupation of malaya until she gains independence it is obvious
that the political social and economic situation of the period influenced rajarao as a young
boy and helped form his ideologies rajarao is hard hitting and critical when he conveys his
opinions about the activities of the prime minister and his cohorts that caused malaysia to be

regarded as the worst kleptocratic country in the world however the reader becomes aware of how much rajarao loves and despairs for malaysia as he shares how she is being torn apart by race and religion based policies no doubt there is much that can be regarded as controversial or confrontational but that is inevitable when truth is told the book is intensely personal and immensely interesting he is brutally honest as he admits his mistakes and apologizes this book is recommended reading for the young and the old as it is both a history book as well as an autobiography it is dribbled with sharp observations on life and draws the reader into a different era yet it also educates them and recommends a purpose driven life the odyssey is certainly most thought provoking enlightening and stimulating

this story is about a man who had finally reached the end of his rope with the christian assault on his soul it was an assault that came at him from all directions burying him in theological contradictions by this time in his life he had given up on his faith and decided to walk away and let the chips fall where they may he would lead his life one day at a time and to hell with who was right and who was wrong it wasn't going to be a pleasant experience coming his way in this middle world that he suddenly found himself in but it would wind up being a turning point in his life a turning point that would bring him back into the fold for the shepherd is a jealous caretaker and dreads the loss of a single member of his flock all of his issues would not be resolved but the events happening in this place beyond the grave would ultimately strengthen his faith and would serve as his shield against further attacks from the adversary follow him on his journey as he finds himself stranded somewhere between heaven and hell

this memoir odyssey of akyemkwaa is a coming of age story written with finesse and encompasses narrations which evoke scenes in a documentary movie the main character siam erzuah is a sales representative working for the sheehy auto group in alexandria virginia encouraged by his appreciative customers as well as others he reveals his personal life stories with a surprising flair of an accomplished story teller from the beginning the book takes the reader to the village of agona mankrong in ghana where erzuah was born in the early stages of his life he becomes conscious of his parents constant financial woes as a result he decides not to follow their subsistence farming occupation his father also had an additional job as a field assistant for the ministry of agriculture helping cocoa farmers in succinct language the book portrays erzuah as having a profound distaste for subsistence farming out of various reasons including his morbid fear of snakes hence he decides to take the education route to have a better job in the future despite the desire to be educated the

book tells of how erzuah almost had his secondary school admission cancelled because of prolonged sickness and subsequent death of his elder brother a situation which causes his parents to be financially incapacitated out of desperation his parents want to postpone his education but erzuah will hear none of it his insistence on going to school forces his father to ask for help from his friend a move that causes erzuah to end up in a virtual domestic slavery throughout his secondary and college education the book traces erzua's struggles and progress with candor and humor at one point he is cornered and beaten up by a student gang of five for no reason on another occasion he steals a roasted plantain when he could not contain his hunger anymore but gets caught and punished his first job at ghanas bureau of national investigations and subsequent travel to the united states caps a life full of drama successes failures and also determination as a coming of age story odyssey of akyemkwaa represents the archetypal rite de passage experienced by the average male growing up in sub saharan africa it is a life story often times seen only on tvs in america and other western countries this is a must read book for all adults college students and those who find themselves under unbearable stress in life

the scamp odyssey is the first in a new series by the author telling of annual trailer trips from 2004 to 2022 the title is inspired by the motorcycle diary in part i the author details travel from vallecito lake colorado to backus minnesota and return a 4000 mile trip he details places passed and visited with commentary on the local history towns of the san luis valley in colorado walsenburg la junta and lamar in colorado then across kansas syracuse johnson and farm country ulysses the mennonite heritage country in kansas and his hometown abilene are followed by the kansas flint hills marysville and its trails west wildlife refuges in iowa nebraska south dakota and minnesota follow reflecting the author and his wife s interest in birding the main character of the book the scamp trailer follows from its factory in backus a test run to duluth and the north shore of lake superior the gran portage wolves at ely across farmland of south dakota pierre and the missouri river and finally laramie rocky mountain national park and home to vallecito part ii a return to the plains of kansas and nebraska in 2011 follows trains planes and the scamp

decades hence the author hopes to promote greater understanding of the historical significance of the Korean War which has been labeled the forgotten war it was an undeclared war for which none of the belligerent parties excepting North Korea was fully prepared at the start close to 4.5 million human beings less than half of whom were in military service were killed injured or reported missing during the 37 months and two days of its duration North Korea South Korea and China suffered the greatest number of casualties both military and civilian the total for the United States alone was 136,826 combatants the Korean War brought us perilously close to a third world war that almost certainly would have been nuclear it was the first war in which American infantry units were fully integrated blacks and whites serving harmoniously together and it was the only real war to have been fought under the aegis and flag of the United Nations it stands out as a chapter in the annals of warfare that contains many important lessons for us all and in this book it is the constant backdrop against which the protagonist's experiences and thought processes are highlighted as they unfold before our eyes
